


#### Blockchain

A digital database or ledger that is distributed among the nodes of a peer-to-peer network.




# EUROLAB survey Digitalisation needs and challenges

Do you and your employees educate yourselves about digital technologies which could be useful?




- Yes, continuously
- Not continuously, but we are following news about digital trends and solutions and pick education of interest from time to time
- Only if there is an urgent need
- No, i.e. I can't remember when we had last education or some information about the newest digital trends and solutions for laboratories

- Transferring data from measuring instrument to PC or notebook
- Automatic formatting of data, i.e. the decreased time needed for formatting
- Automatic calculations needed for the report, i.e. decreased time needed for formatting
- Automatic generating of the final report, i.e. decreased time needed for writing the report
- Automated data analysis such as machine learning algorithms and models, etc.
- Communication with the customer
   Communication with various institutions, like
  - legal/accreditation bodies, metrology institutes, etc.



- The costs for digitalisation
- Lack of IT infrastructure
- Lack of expertise or staff training in digital tools
- Difficulty integrating digital tools with existing systems
- Security and data privacy concerns
- Lack of awareness of available digital tools
- Lack of interoperability/compatibility between different applications and IT systems, e.g. problems with different data formatting, etc.


What are the primary challenges your laboratory faces when it comes to digitalisation?




