### **EUROLAB Position Paper on the impact and revision of the New Legislative Framework (Regulation 765/2008)**

EUROLAB, as a European association representing laboratories and other conformity assessment bodies (CABs), sees the revision of the New Legislative Framework (NLF) as an important opportunity to refocus on more efficient accreditation in Europe that can enable a sustainable quality infrastructure and strengthen the European Single Market.

Modification 28.04.2026: Digital Product Passport (DPP)

EUROLAB supports the DPP as a digital complement to the New Legislative Framework to consolidate compliance evidence, improve safety-relevant version control, and enable more effective market surveillance and circularity. Support depends on strict guardrails: purpose limitation, data minimisation, role-based access, resilient architecture, and clear liability rules.
